One-Block Third Street between Market and Jefferson to Close Jan. 3

Louisville, KY (December 29, 2016) – As part of the Kentucky International Convention Center expansion project, a one-block section of Third Street between Market Street and Jefferson Street will close to vehicular traffic on Jan. 3 at 6 a.m. The street will be closed for 10 months in the interest of public safety, as the exhibit hall located above Third Street is demolished and new structural steel is moved into place.

Timed traffic signals and on-site support from traffic control should moderate the inconvenience of the detour. Travelers should pre-plan alternate routes, using the Waze app or Google Maps to find alternate routes.
